





## Corrections at the end of 2025


The 2025 performance period ends on Wednesday 31 December 2025.



# Using the NVES Portal to prepare for your IEV



You can view, filter and export information about your entity's covered vehicles in the 'Vehicles' page of the NVES Portal.



NVES: Dashboard > Vehicles

## Vehicles

This page shows the NVES covered vehicles that have been entered on the Register of Approved Vehicles (RAV) for the regulated entity you are representing.

You can:

- View information about each covered vehicle, such as NVES vehicle type, carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) emissions, mass in running order (MIRO), and the emissions target.
- Sort and filter the vehicles shown in the table.
- Export NVES data into an Excel file.





## What data will be published, and why?


### **Division 2—Publication and sharing of information**

#### **86 Publication of information**

- (1) The Secretary must publish the following information on the Department's website:
  - (a) for each person for whom there is a covered vehicle for a year beginning on or after 1 January 2025—the person's interim emissions value for the year;
  - (b) the name of each person who has a registry account;
  - (c) the number of units held in each registry account;
  - (d) such other information as is prescribed by the rules.
- (2) The Secretary must publish a person's interim emissions value for a year under subsection (1) as soon as practicable after the interim reconciliation day for the year.
- (3) The Secretary must ensure that information published under subsection (1) is kept up to date.

# How do I know who to trade with?






